A Proclamation

National Senior Citizens Day, August 21, 2017

By the President of the United States of America

Whereas, senior citizens have enriched our culture, cared for the next generation and provided by their lifetime achievements positive role models for all Americans, and

Whereas, the experiences, wisdom and accomplishments of seniors are a teaching guide for all Americans, and

Whereas, there is a higher percentage of participation in civics including voting in primary and general elections for senior citizens than any other segment of our society, making them literally the bedrock of our society, and

Whereas, a virtual War on Seniors has been waged with policies that unfairly tax their wealth, limit their healthcare choices, promote euthanasia, express disrespect, contempt and hostility for them, and with inflation caused by government overspending reduce the value of their savings and fixed income, and

Whereas, the War on Seniors has reduced the standard of living of many senior citizens and threatens to get worse unless these policies are reversed,

Therefore, this proclamation shall serve as notice that the War on Seniors is over and that government policies at all levels should in the future be adopted that will improve the standard of living and recognize and honor the achievements of America's senior citizens,

Now therefore it is resolved that all Americans should respect and show our esteem and gratitude to senior citizens by never again forcing them to bear an unfair share of the tax burden, and

It is further resolved and recommended that all Americans should be thankful and express gratitude to seniors for their productive lives and achievements, and

Be it further resolved that we encourage senior citizens to continue to participate as volunteers and donors in their contributions to charities, churches, causes and in their community, and

Be it resolved, that we encourage and thank those who welcome and work with senior citizens in communities – churches, senior citizen centers, clubs and associations across our land,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, DONALD J. TRUMP, President of the United States of America, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the United States, do hereby proclaim August 21, 2017, as National Senior Citizens Day and this week, August 20 through August 26, as National Senior Citizens Week. Today and this week, I call upon Americans to pay special tribute to Senior Citizens, and to observe this week with appropriate ceremonies and activities honoring their important contributions to society as wise in their years and enriching future generations.
